1	Psychiatrist	MD/DNB Psychiatry	Clinical assessments, coordinate the activities of the study centre, training of manpower, prepare SOPs for the study
2	General Physician	MBBS or DPM Proficiency in Kannada language is mandatory. Telugu language familiarity is desirable	Conducting medical assessments of study participants, clinical examination including complete physical and neurological examination, anthropometric assessment and overseeing investigations.
3	Psychiatric Social Worker	Post-graduate in Psychiatric Social Work, with experience of working in the community setting. Proficiency in Kannada/Telugu languages is preferred	Perform field assessments, conduct and co-ordinate awareness programs and other activities in the community; facilitate recruitment and psychosocial assessments of study participants.
4	Psychologist	Post-graduate in Psychology with experience of conducting cognitive assessments. Proficiency in Kannada/Telugu languages is preferred	Perform cognitive assessments on study participants.
5	Field Manager	Post Graduate in Social Work with proficiency in interviewing and collecting information from individuals in the community, conducting community programs. Proficiency in Kannada/Telugu languages is must.	Managing and resolving issues related to participant recruitment, supervising field data supervisors, basic data management.

6	Field Supervisor	Post Graduate in Social Work with proficiency in interviewing and collecting information from individuals in the community, conducting community programs. Proficiency in Kannada/Telugu languages is must	Managing field data collectors, supervising field data collectors, basic data management.
7	Field Data Collectors	Graduate in any field preferably with some field experience of interviewing and collecting information from individuals in the community. Proficiency in Kannada/Telugu languages is must	Recruiting participants for the study by going door to door in the community, explaining about the study to participants, collecting basic socio-demographic information, assist in conducting and coordinating awareness programs in the field etc.
8	Nurse	General Nursing and Mid-Wifery (GNM), with experience of handling patients. Proficiency in Kannada language is must. Familiarity with Telugu language is desirable	Collection of blood samples, measuring of Blood Pressure, Vitals etc., assisting the medical officer.
